Parking: You must pay for parking. Parking is \$15 on weekdays and \$10 on weekends and is cashless. There will not be a parking attendant at the venue. All students must **arrive at the Carpenter Performing Arts Center ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE PERFORMANCE** dressed in costume with hair and make-up done. **The backstage doors will close 30 minutes prior to show time.**

Students should be dropped off and picked up at the backstage entrance. They will remain with an assigned staff member before and after their performance. The 11:00 show is approximately 1 hour long. All other shows are approximately 2 ½ - 3 hours long. **STUDENTS WILL BE RELEASED TO THEIR PARENTS AT THE END OF THE SHOW.**

Students participating in **ONLY ONE DANCE** should arrive “empty handed” wearing the dance shoes that they will perform in. **NO CELL PHONES, SNACKS, DRINKS, SWEATERS, DANCE BAGS, CHANGE OF CLOTHES, ETC.**

Dancers with costume changes – Students in multiple dances in the same show should come to the theater on their performance day in the costume of their first dance in the recital. Please note that this dance may be different than the first dance performed at dress rehearsal. Everything, including shoes, costumes, and accessories, should be labeled with the dancer’s first and last name (initials will do on accessories.) All accessories and hair needs should be put in a zip-lock bag attached to the hanger of each corresponding costume. **All** hangers should be in **ONE clear garment bag with the dancer’s full name printed boldly on the outside.** Please send only the costumes needed for each performance. No cell phones, food, street clothes, books, extra shoes, etc. We appreciate your cooperation in this matter.

NO FLASH PHOTOGRAPHY OR VIDEOTAPING ALLOWED ON THE DAY OF THE PERFORMANCE. This is to insure that all audience members are able to view the performance. We have booked a company to professionally videotape all performances. Order forms will be available in the office and at all performances.

Center Stage Dance Academy’s security policy does not allow the release of ANY dancers during the performance or at intermission. **ANY STUDENT LEAVING BEFORE THE END OF THE PERFORMANCE OR SITTING IN THE AUDIENCE DURING THEIR SCHEDULED PERFORMANCE WILL BE EXCUSED FROM THE STUDIO.**
